ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF QUINTANA, TEXAS CERTIFYING THAT THERE IS NO CANDIDATE OPPOSED NOR ANY WRITE-IN CANDIDATE IN THE 2016 GENERAL ELECTION; CANCELLING THE ELECTION AND DECLARING THE WINNERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 2, TEXAS ELECTION CODE; CONTAINING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF QUINTANA, TEXAS:

First, the City Council of the Town of Quintana, Texas, certifies that none of the three candidates for the three positions on the ballot for the 2016 Regular General Election is opposed, and that no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates for those offices under applicable law.

Second, the 2016 General Election for the City Council of the Town of Quintana, Texas is hereby cancelled, and Mike Fletcher is declared elected to Position Three, Macedonio Salinas is declared elected to Position Four and Debbie Alongis is declared elected to Position Five of the City Council. Such persons will take office in accordance with State law following the date that election would have been held.

Third, a copy of this ordinance shall be posted on Election Day at each polling place(s) that would have been used in the election.

Fourth, in the event any section or provision of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, void, or inoperative by the final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such defective provision, if any, is hereby declared to be severable from the remaining sections and provisions. This ordinance and such remaining sections and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Fifth, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately.
